Mike Rowe has been driving race cars for forty-five years and as evident from this past racing season, the veteran driver has not slowed down one bit. From the moment he climbed into his first race car at the age of eighteen, Mike has been a frequent visitor to victory lane – at least two hundred visits.

Mike's list of accomplishments are staggering – over two hundred victories, fifteen championships, six Triple Crown series championships, three OXFORD 250 wins and much, much more. He has competed on tracks from the Canadian Maritimes to Daytona International Speedway and as far west as the famed 'Milwaukee Mile'.

At his home track of Oxford Plains Speedway, Mike has won seven track championships ('76, '78-'81, '89-'90), six Triple Crown series titles ('72-'73, '80-'81, '88-'89), three OXFORD 250 wins ('84, '97, 2005) and one hundred and fifty wins. He has won a track championship at Wiscasset Soedway, an ACT Pro Stock Tour championship (1984), a NEPSA (Northeast Pro Stock Association) title (1999), a PASS Super Late Model South Series championship (2008) and most recently two Beech Ridge Motor Speedway championships and Maine NASCAR State Championships (2009, 2013).

Even though a great majority of Mike's victories have been in a full-fender Late Model/Pro Stock-type car, he showed he was equally adept in a Modified winning several races.

Mike is respected by his peers and the racing community for not only his accomplishments on the track but for his generosity off the track, especially with children.
