Kelly Moore is a true Maine racing iron-man. In a driving career that has spanned over 40 years, Kelly continues to push back the hands of time, still finding his way to victory lane. He began driving for his father Richard Moore in the late 70's at Wiscasset Speedway, taking over a car once driven by Hall of Famer Teddy Palino. Before too long he took his talents north to Oxford Plains Speedway, winning the track championship in 1984. He continued to move up the racing ladder and became a fixture in the Busch Grand National North Series from 1987 – 2007. Over that time Kelly set all time marks in the series for most career wins (27), and most poles (45), plus others including top 5's and top 10's. He was the 1995 NASCAR Busch North champion. As he has transitioned into the later years of his career, he has had the pleasure of racing against and guiding the career of his son Ryan. Kelly Moore continues to race even now in Super Late Models, coming full circle in 2022 as he won an emotional first race at Wiscasset, the place where he turned his first laps in a race car so many years ago. In 2021 Kelly was inducted into the NEAR Hall of Fame and now adds Maine Motorsports Hall of Fame class of 2022 to his incredible resume.
